UNIT 2 REVIEW (PART 2)

Hoy repasamos el **PAST SIMPLE** (Pasado Simple), que como recordaréis, se utiliza para hablar de eventos del pasado que empezaron y ya terminaron. "Ayer **estuve** en la playa...", "La semana pasada Anna **fue** al cine"...

Para formar el Pasado Simple en inglés, tenemos primero que saber que existen dos tipos de verbos: los **regulares** y los **irregulares**. Los **regulares** son los más sencillos: bastaba con añadirles "-d", "-ed" o "-ied", dependiendo del verbo.

Ejemplos de verbos regulares:

- Save → saved
- Play → played
- Study → studied

Los verbos **irregulares** eran un poco más complejos, porque no había que añadirles nada, sino que tenían su propia forma.

Ejemplos de verbos irregulares:

- Find → found
- Eat → ate
- Drink → drank

I jumped...

I **didn't** jump...
You **didn't** eat...
He **didn't** cook...
She **didn't** write...
It **didn't** run...
We **didn't** shout...
You **didn't** read...
They **didn't** open...

INT?

Did I jump...?
Did you eat...?
Did he cook...?
Did she write...?
Did it run...?
Did we shout...?
Did you read...?
Did they open...?

REGULAR VERBS: just add +ed in the AFF+, didn't NEG- and Did+pers.pronoun (he, they, you...)? in the INT ?
IRREGULAR VERBS: in the AFF+ different form (write-wrote)
NEG - didn't, Did + personal pronoun (he, she, we...) in the INT ?

Recordad, además, que cuando hacemos frases en **NEGATIVO** o **INTERROGATIVO**, el verbo volvía a su forma original (sin -ed, ni cambiarlo si es irregular).
