6. The kids(visit) their grandparents two days ago.
7. You(tell) me about it already.
8. I(read) over 7 books this month.
9. We(discuss) that problem many weeks ago.
10. Here are your shoes. I (just/clean) them.

Put the verbs into the correct tense (Past Simple or Present Perfect):

A:(you / taste / ever) sushi?

B: Yes, I(eat) sushi at least five times so far.



A: When(you / eat) sushi for the first time?

B: I(eat) sushi for the first time on my dad's 50th birthday. He(invite) the whole family to a Japanese restaurant.

A:(you / like) it?

B: Absolutely. In fact, it(be) so good that we(be) to that restaurant three times yet. And on my mum's birthday, we(order) some sushi and(have) it at home.
