B. GRAMMAR

I. COMPOUND NOUNS

Compound nouns are nouns including two or more words combined. Compound nouns can be written as two separate words with a hyphen between the two words or combined into one word.

Types of Compound Nouns			Example
Noun	+	Noun	toothpick, schoolboy, tennis ball, kitchen table...
Adjective	+	Noun	quicksilver, greenhouse, blackbird...
Noun	+	Gerund	weight-lifting, lorry driving, coal-mining...
Gerund	+	Noun	waiting-room, swimming pool, driving licence...
<i>Other situations:</i>			
Adjective	+	Verb	whitewash...
Verb	+	Noun	pickpocket...
Adverb	+	Verb	outbreak...
Verb	+	Adverb	breakdown...
Noun	+	Preposition	passer-by, looker-on...
Noun	+	Adjective	secretary-general...

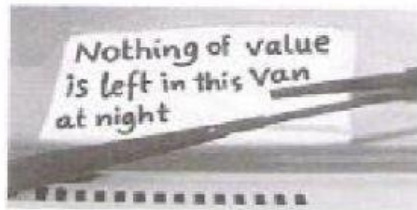

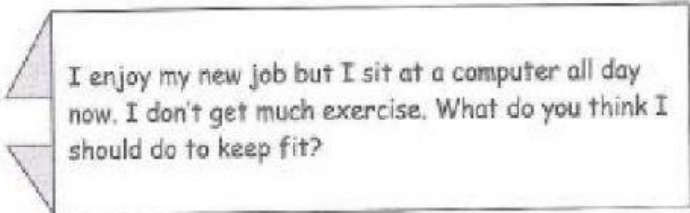
