The second man on the moon

Buzz Aldrin ^{was} born Edwin Eugene Aldrin, Jr. on January 20, 1930 and ^{was} in New Jersey, U.S. After he ^{graduated} high school, he ^{went} to college and later studied for a PhD at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. Then he ^{found} a job – as an astronaut with NASA. In 1969, he was the second person to walk on the moon. He left his job at NASA in 1971, after a total of 289 hours and 53 minutes in space. He ^{later} married three times and he ^{has} three children: two sons and a daughter.
