

COMMON FACTORS

What are common factors? Let's look and learn from the examples shown.

Example 1

Find the common factors of 6 and 9.

Factors of 6 are 1, 2, 3 and 6.

These numbers are
called COMMON
FACTORS.

Factors of 9 are 1, 3 and 9.

6

1 x 6

2 x 3

9

1 x 9

3 x 3

Answer: The common factors of 6 and 9 are 1 and 3.

Example 2

Find the common factors of 12 and 16.

Factors of 12 are 1, 2, 3, 4, 6 and 12.

12

1 x 12

2 x 6

3 x 4

Factors of 16 are 1, 2, 4, 8 and 16.

16

1 x 16

2 x 8

4 x 4

Answer: The common factors of 12 and 16 are 1, 2 and 4.

Example 3

Find the common factors of 4, 6 and 12.

Factors of 4 are 1, 2 and 4.



4



1 x 4

2 x 2



Factors of 6 are 1, 2, 3 and 6.



6



1 x 6

2 x 3



Factors of 12 are 1, 2, 3, 4, 6 and 12.



12



1 x 12

2 x 6

3 x 4

Answer: The common factors of 4, 6 and 12 are 1 and 2.
