Josh is a . He works with a team of rescue workers in Scotland. Josh has got a very good sense of smell. He uses his nose to find people lost in the mountains.

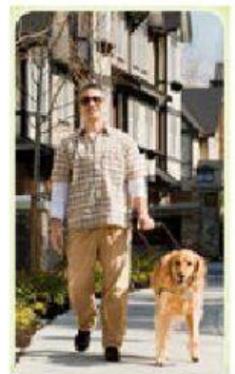
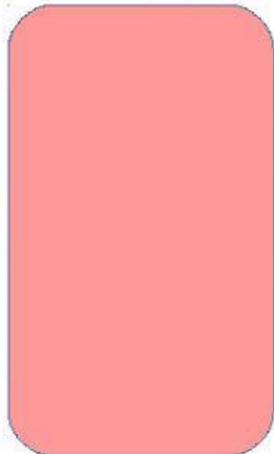
