- ✓ One syllable
- ✓ Two syllables ending -y

Example: the girls are thinner than boys

Long adjectives: ending more/less

- ✓ Two syllables
- ✓ Three syllables
- ✓ Four syllables
- ✓ More syllables

Example: the girls are more generous than boys

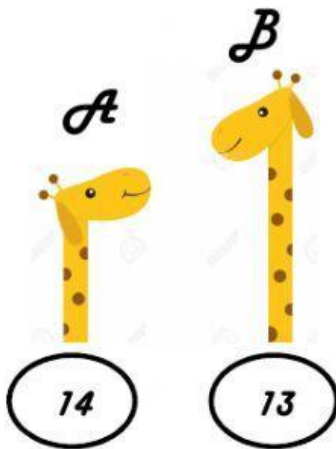

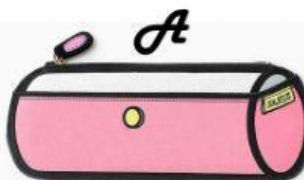

- ✓ Two syllable
- ✓ Three syllable
- ✓ Four syllable
- ✓ More syllable

Example: the girls are the most generous

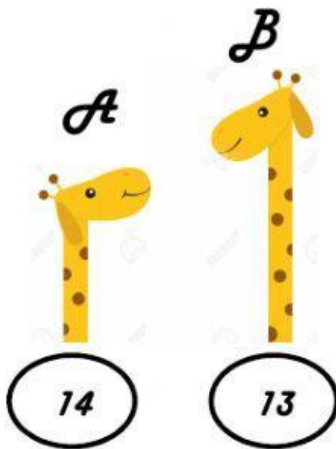

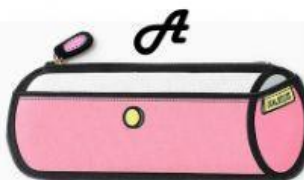
