

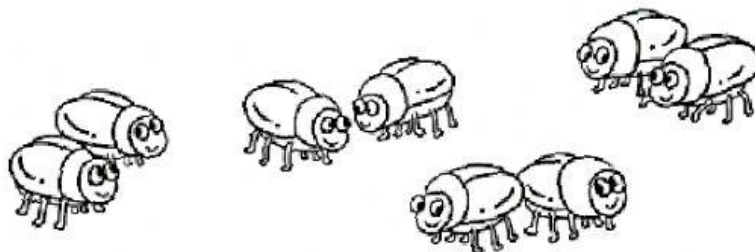
Practice 1 Multiplication: Adding the Same Number
