Remember!

- Verbs which end in **-s, -sh, -ch, -x, -o** takes **-es** in the third person singular, e.g. *I wash.* – *He washes.*
- Verbs which end in **-e**, take **-s**. e.g. *I dance.* – *He dances.*
- Verbs which end in a **consonant + -y** change the **-y** to **-i** and take **-es**. e.g. *I fly.* – *It flies.*
- Verbs with end in a **vowel + -y** simply take **-s**. e.g. *I play.* – *She plays.*
