

# Gerunds Homework

Gerunds are noun forms of verbs. They all end in -ing, and are formed following these rules:

- For most verbs, just add -ing.  
Ex: walk → walking      play → playing      surf → surfing
- For verbs that end in "e," delete the "e" then add -ing.  
Ex: skate → skating      dance → dancing      ride → riding
- For single-syllable verbs ending in a consonant + vowel + consonant, double the final consonant then add -ing.  
Ex: run → running      swim → swimming      hit → hitting
