

ASEXUAL REPRODUCTION IN PLANTS

STOLONS

...are stems that a gardener separates from the parent plant.

These stems produce new roots.

TUBERS

...are stems that grow horizontally above the ground. These stems produce roots and a new plant grows.

RHIZOMES

...are horizontal underground stems. New plants grow from these stems.

CUTTINGS

...grow underground at the bottom of the stem.
A new plant grows from each ...

BULBS

...are underground stems. They store many nutrients from the soil.
