

Transitive or Intransitive Verbs

- ⦿ Verbs with Direct Objects are called Transitive verbs.
- ⦿ The action is in “transit” from the subject to the direct object.
- ⦿ Example:
 - Bob eats a burger.
 - Bob shoots Steven.
 - Bob gives Steven a cookie.
- ⦿ All sentences lacking direct objects are intransitive.
- ⦿ This means all linking verb sentences are intransitive.
