##### Suggested Structure & Writing Ideas

- Say thank you to Avril.
- Explain why you were not at home.
- Tell Avril that you (don't) need him to come back.
- Say if you have done your homework and if you need the book.

*First, Then, Next, Maybe, Probably, Finally*

##### Suggested Structure & Writing Ideas

- Give the boy a name.
- Write where the boy was, and what he did/was doing there.
- Write where the boy was in the second picture.
- Write why the boy was in the kitchen, in the third picture, and say what he was doing there.

#### SAMPLE ANSWER - Question 32
