

Way of Expressing the Future

Read the rules and fill in with WILL, BE GOING TO, PRESENT CONTINUOUS or PRESENT SIMPLE.

1. We use + infinitive to make predictions about the future (often after verbs such as hope, expect, think).
2. We use + infinitive to talk about future plans and intentions.
3. We use to talk about future arrangements.
4. We can use with a future meaning, but only to talk about timetables in the future.
5. We use + infinitive and for promises or for making decisions or offers at the time of speaking.
6. We use + infinitive for predictions with evidence.
