

Practice 6 Division using Multiplication Facts

1. Study the multiplication sentence.
Then, write two division sentences.

Example

$$6 \times 7 = 42$$

$$42 \div \underline{6} = \underline{7}$$

$$42 \div \underline{7} = \underline{6}$$



(a) $9 \times 4 = 36$
