Un embudo = funnel

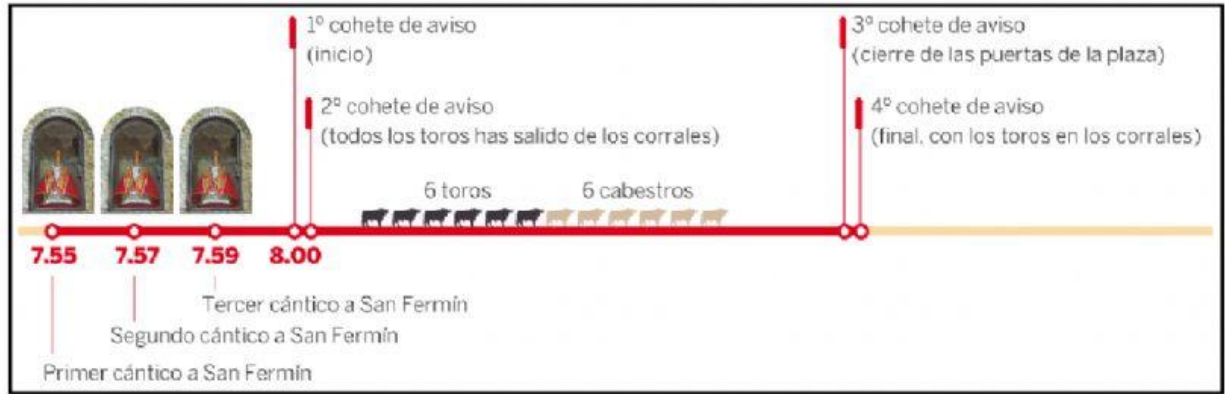
