## Present Simple: Affirmative – Negative – Interrogative.



1. My sister \_\_\_\_\_ her teeth every morning. (brush)
2. You and I \_\_\_\_\_ our bikes in winter. (not ride)
3. \_\_\_\_\_ you \_\_\_\_\_ comics every day? (read)
4. Skunks \_\_\_\_\_ in the savannah. (not live)
5. \_\_\_\_\_ the firefighter \_\_\_\_\_ fires? (stop)
6. I \_\_\_\_\_ in the pool every summer. (swim)

## Present Progressive: Affirmative – Negative – Interrogative.

1. We \_\_\_\_\_ to music at this moment. (listen)
2. My grandpa \_\_\_\_\_ TV right now. (not watch)
3. \_\_\_\_\_ you \_\_\_\_\_ computer games now? (play)
4. I \_\_\_\_\_ to the beach at this moment. (go)
5. \_\_\_\_\_ the raccoon \_\_\_\_\_ a tree now? (climb)
6. Daniela \_\_\_\_\_ trash in the park. (recycle)
