Past simple: regular verbs

Affirmative: Subject + verb + ed

I / You / He / She / It / We / They talk .

Negative : Subj. + didn't + verb

I / You / He / She / It / We / They talk.

Uses

We use the past simple to talk about actions or situations in the .

We **watched** TV last night.

I **visit** London in 2016.

Past simple affirmative spelling rules

With most regular verbs, we add *-ed*.

walk – **walked**

explain – **explain**

With regular verbs that end in *-e*, we add *-d*.

describe – **describe**

phone – **phone**

With regular verbs that end in a vowel + consonant, we double the consonant and add *-ed*.

rob – **rob**

travel – **travel**

With regular verbs that end in *-y*, we omit the *-y* and add *-ied*.

carry – **carried**

try – **tried**

We often include past time expressions in past simple sentences.

I **talked** to Jenna **yesterday**.

They **travelled** around France **last summer**.

We **played** basketball **at the weekend**.
