

IRREGULAR VERBS

The past simple of irregular verbs is formed in a different way,

you **don't** add **-ed** to the verb.

NO: go - **goed** YES: go - **went**

In affirmative we have to memorize a list, each past is different.



Subjet + verb in past form

I **went** (Yo fui)

to go - **went**

to be - **was/were**

to have - **had**

to make - **made**

*Para formar el pasado de verbos irregulares tenemos que memorizar el pasado de cada verbo (solo en afirmativo)

To make the negative we use **did not** or **didn't**
(the same as the regular verbs)

Subjet + did + not + verb in infinitive

She **didn't** go (Ella no fue)

*Cuando usamos el

"**did**" utilizamos el
infinitivo, no la forma en
pasado

To make the interrogative we use **did**.

Did + Subjet + verb in infinitive ...?

Did they go?? (¿Ellos fueron?)

*Todos los sujetos se
forman igual (I, You, She,
They...)
