a person employed to perform cleaning and vacuuming, sweeping, emptying trash cans, dusting shelves, cleaning windows, and mopping floors of a room in a hotel.

a person, esp. a man, who waits on tables, as in a restaurant

A person in charge of the overall operations for the kitchen area of a restaurant.

concierge

waiter

a person employed to carry luggage and other loads in hotel

is a person who works in the restaurant and catering industry clearing tables.

a professional cook, typically the chief trained cook in a restaurant or hotel.

a person employed in a hotel to receive guests and deal with their bookings check in and out.
