Tanjidor is Betawi music instruments. It is usually played by men. They play *tanjidor* happily on Betawi wedding ceremonies or circumcisions. Betawi folksongs such as *Jali-Jali* and *Sirih Kuning* are entertainingly presented when they are playing *tanjidor*.

Tanjidor is famously known in Betawi. The word *tanjidor* can be said originally taken from the word *tangedor*. It means stringed instruments in Portuguese. Its instruments are greatly influenced by European music. They are drums, saxophones, clarinets, cymbals, trombones and pistons. Others say that tanjidor historically comes from Japanese, tanji, occupying Betawi.
