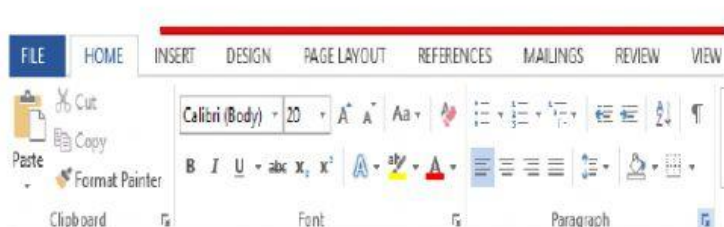


Lesson 8 Setting Default Paragraph Alignment

Setting Default Paragraph Alignment

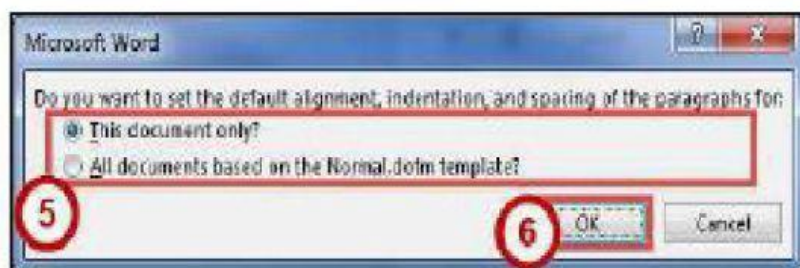
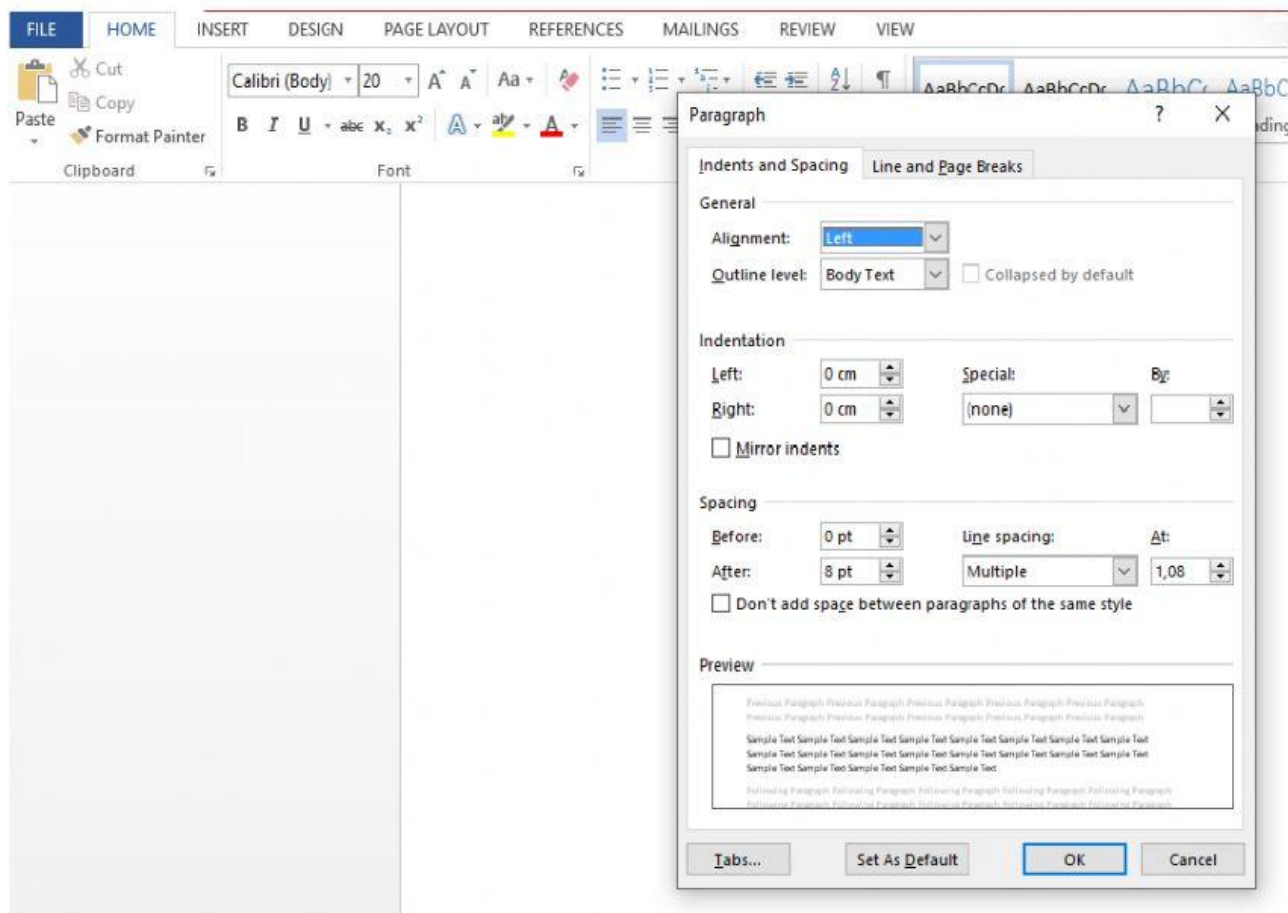
You can change the default paragraph alignment options so is always spaced how you want it to be in Word. Alignment, indentation, and line spacing are all set from the Paragraph dialog box. The following explains how to change the default paragraph options:

1. Click the **Home** Tab.
2. In the **Paragraph** group, click the **Paragraph Dialog Box Launcher**.



The paragraph Dialog Box Launcher is at the bottom right hand corner of the paragraph box. Once you have right clicked from your mouse the below menu will appear

3. In the **Font Dialog box**, you can change the **Font**, **Font style**, **Size**, **Font color**, **Underline style** and **Effects**.
4. Click **Set as Default**
5. In the Set as Default dialog box. Make a **selection** based on your preference.
6. Click the **OK** button.
