
## Countable and uncountable nouns (with *lots of, some, a few, a little, any*)

Countable nouns are things that we can count. They have a singular form and a plural form.  
Uncountable nouns are things we can't count. They always use *is / isn't*.


Countable nouns	Uncountable nouns
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ There <b>are</b> <b>lots of</b> sweets.</li><li>✓ There <b>are</b> <b>some</b> sweets.</li><li>✓ There <b>are</b> <b>a few</b> sweets.</li><li>✗ There <b>aren't</b> <b>any</b> sweets.</li></ul> <p>Are there <b>any</b> sweets? Yes, there <b>are</b>. / No, there <b>aren't</b>.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ There <b>is</b> <b>lots of</b> milk.</li><li>✓ There <b>is</b> <b>some</b> milk.</li><li>✓ There <b>is</b> <b>a little</b> milk.</li><li>✗ There <b>isn't</b> <b>any</b> milk.</li></ul> <p>Is there <b>any</b> milk? Yes, there <b>is</b>. / No, there <b>isn't</b>.</p>
