

Learning Content**Parts of a map**

On a map there are **labels**, a **key**, a **scale** and a **compass rose**.



Labels. This is the text on the map. The text tells us the names of the places. On this physical map of India, the text tells us the names of the features.

The key. This is the box that explains the symbols and colors on the map.

The scale. This is a line with numbers. The numbers on the right shows how many times the real distance is reduced on the map. The scale is also used for calculating distance.

The compass rose. A map shows the four points of the compass (North, South, East and West) with their initials N, S, E and W. It helps us to find different places.


