Depuis la fiche numero 10, nous avons commencé à découvrir le PRETERIT. C'est le moment de faire l'état des lieux, avant d'aller plus loin.

Le **PRETERIT** est le temps du passé en anglais.

AFFIRMATIVE SENTENCES	NEGATIVE SENTENCES	INTERROGATIVE SENTENCES
I was	I was not	Was I ...?
You were	You were not	Were you ...?
He was	He was not	Was he ...?
She was	She was not	Was she ...?
It was	It was not	Was it ...?
We were	We were not	Were we ...?
You were	You were not	Were you ...?
They were	They were not	Were they ...?

Note: wasn't (= was not)
weren't (= were not)

Le verbe BE est simple, pour rappel, voici sa conjugaison.

En ce qui concerne les autres verbes, on peut les ranger en deux catégories : les verbes réguliers (fiche 13) et les verbes irréguliers

LES VERBES REGULIERS :

Pour les mettre au passé, on leur rajoute -ED (played, lived, liked, hated...)

Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative >
I walked	I didn't walk	Did I walk?
You walked	You didn't walk	Did you walk?
He, she, it walked	He didn't walk	Did he walk?
We walked	We didn't walk	Did we walk?
You walked	You didn't walk	Did you walk?
They walked	They didn't walk	Did they walk?
