DOUBLE OBJECT PRONOUNS

BASIC = subj **iop dop conj verb**Juan **nos la trae** a Eva y a mí.

OPTION 1 = subj **conj verb inf.+ iop/dop**Juan **quiere traérmola** a Eva y a mí.
(looks like one word)

OPTION 2 = subj **'estar' -ando, -iendo, (-yendo) + iop/dop**.... Juan **estaba trayéndonola** a Eva y a mí.
(looks like one word)

Command = pos. = **command+iop/dop** (Tráénosla. - Bring it to us.)

neg. = No **iop dop command** (No **nos la traigas**. – Don't bring it to us.)
