## FUTURE TENSE (1)

1. The Future Tense Tense is used to talk about things that will happen **after now**.  
(Future Tense digunakan untuk mengatakan sesuatu perkara/perbuatan yang akan dilakukan dimasa hadapan.)
2. To use the Future Tense, you just add 'will' before the verb.  
(Untuk mengguna Future Tense , anda cuna tambah 'will' sebelum kata kerja.)
3. To make a negative Future Tense, just add 'will not' (or won't) before the verb.,  
(Untuk membuat Future Tense negatif , cuna tambah 'will not' (atau won't) sebelum kata kerja.)

Examples:

1. I will play badminton tomorrow. (**Saya akan main badminton esok.**)
2. They won't give me money next week. (**Mereka tidak akan beri saya duit minggu hadapan.**)
3. Aqil will be in shoolnext year. (**Aqil akan ada di sekolah tahun hadapan.**)
