#### Notes

One example is given for each type of question.

- **Context:** (Question 2) The correct answer is **A** (*deceitful*). The deceitful boy tried to conceal the truth from his parents. The clue in the context is 'tried to conceal the truth'.
- **Homophones:** (Question 4) The correct answer is **D** (*vain*). Brianna is vain; she is always admiring herself in the mirror. *Vain* means pleased with oneself.
- **Words which look similar:** (Question 5) The correct answer is **A** (*loose*). My six-year-old sister has several loose teeth. *Loose* is an adjective which means not fixed firmly.
- **Synonyms:** (Question 9) Dan is loyal to his friends and supports them when they are in trouble. The correct answer is **B** (*faithful*). *Faithful* is a synonym of *loyal*. You could use the context to help you select the correct option.
- **Antonyms:** (Question 23) It is rare to see such talent in one so young. The correct answer is **B** (*common*). *Common* is opposite in meaning to *rare*. One of the options here (*unusual*) is close in meaning to *rare*. Don't select synonyms by mistake when you answer antonym questions.
