


Adjectives That Compare

REMEMBER THE RULES

- Add **-er** to most adjectives to compare two people, places, or things.
*A Maltese has **longer** fur than a Chihuahua.*
- Add **-est** to most adjectives to compare more than two.
*Pugs are the **largest** of all toy dogs.*




