

Present Perfect Negative

To make negatives in the present perfect, add “not” after “have” or “has.” You can also contract the “have” or “has” with “not”

Examples: I have not studied Japanese. / I haven't studied Japanese.

Erik has not visited France. / Erik hasn't visited France.

The banana has not turned brown yet. / The banana hasn't turned brown yet.

You have not played the piano before. / You haven't played piano before.

They have not called me yet. / They haven't called me yet.
