

# Present Perfect Questions

To form questions in the present perfect, move "have" or "has" in front of the subject. We often use "ever," "before," or "yet" when asking questions in the present perfect.

Examples: I have missed the bus. → Have I missed the bus?  
We have arrived too early. → Have we arrived too early?  
Amanda has played piano before. → Has Amanda played piano before?  
You have visited Brazil. → Have you ever visited Brazil?
