

V. Read about "Tim - a football player"

Every Saturday afternoon Tim plays football with his local team, The Warriors. Tim started playing with them four years ago. Now he is 22 and he would really like to play in a national team. What does Tim do for the rest of the week?

On Sundays he always goes out with his friends. They often meet at the pub to have a drink or go to the cinema when there is an interesting film on.

On Mondays he does the housework and goes shopping to the supermarket. Tim lives alone in a small apartment. He doesn't earn much money as a player of his local team, but it is enough to pay for the rent of the apartment and the food and other expenses he may have.

From Tuesday to Friday he gets up very early to go to the club. The team always practices in the mornings. They usually start at 9:30 and finish at 1:00, when they have lunch at the cafeteria.

On Tuesdays the team doctor sees all the players and checks everything is OK. On Wednesdays the manager shows them a video of Saturday's match. On Thursday the manager watches them play and decides which players are going to play on Saturday. On Saturdays Tim gets up at 8:30 in the morning. He has a big breakfast and goes to the club at 12:00. The match starts at 1:00.
