

PARTS OF SPEECH - sentence formation and practice. Writing and Speaking – Review the examples. Identify the nouns of each sentence. There are three examples to help you.

EXAMPLE #1: Mary studies chemistry.

Mary	Studies	Chemistry.	(none)	(none)
Subject	Verb	Object	Preposition	Object of preposition

Mary = a noun, subject of the sentence.

Chemistry = a noun, object of the verb “studies”

EXAMPLE #2: The children are playing in the park.

The children	are playing	(none)	in	the park
Subject	Verb	Object	Preposition	Object of preposition

Children = a noun, subject of the sentence

The park = a noun, object of the preposition “in”

EXAMPLE #3: Children like candy.

Children	like	candy	(none)	(none)
Subject	Verb	Object	Preposition	Object of preposition

Children = a noun, subject of the sentence

Candy = a noun, object of the verb “like”

4. Robert is reading a book about butterflies.

Subject	Verb	Object	Preposition	Object of preposition

5. The sun is shining.

Subject	Verb	Object	Preposition	Object of preposition

6. Tom and Ann live with their parents.

Subject	Verb	Object	Preposition	Object of preposition

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7. Monkeys eat fruit and insects.

Subject	Verb	Object	Preposition	Object of preposition

8. Mary and Bob help John with his homework.

Subject	Verb	Object	Preposition	Object of preposition
