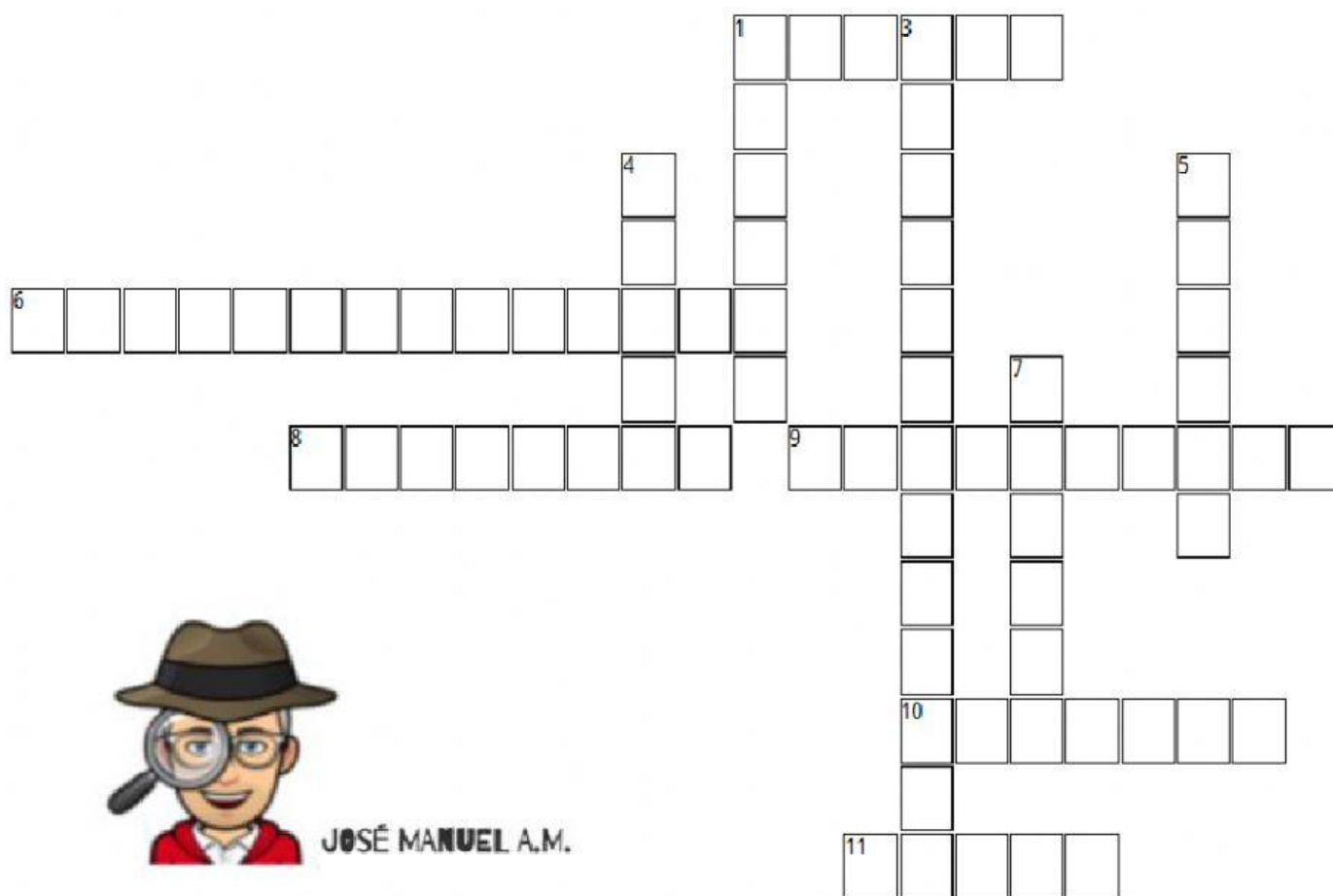


Vocabulary U4 - Around my town

Horizontales

1. a three-dimensional work of art, as a figure of a person, carved in stone or wood, etc.
6. a building with different group of stores, shops, restaurants, etc.
8. the chief building in which municipal business is transacted, often with a hall for public meetings
9. a room or building for the display or sale of works of art: pictures, statues, etc.
10. an enclosed area of ice for skating, ice hockey or other sports.
11. an area of sand along a shore (the land along the edge of a sea, lake, etc.)

Verticales

1. an open area formed at the place where two or more streets meet:
3. an office in many towns and cities where tourists can get information on interesting things to see and do in the local area, help with finding somewhere to stay, and advice on travel.
4. a commercial establishment offering lodging to travelers and sometimes to permanent residents, and often having restaurants, meeting rooms, stores, etc., that are available to the general public.
5. a place where buyers and sellers meet for the sale of goods: vegetable, fruits, etc.
7. a fortified, protected building, usually with a wall around it, owned by a prince or noble esp. in former times.
