### **How Do Gender Roles Impact Marriage?**

There are lots of reasons why marriages can fail today, one of them involves how gender roles have changed.

Couples generally fall into one of two cases: some may support the traditional perspective of male **breadwinner**/female homemaker, others may hold the more modern view that men and women are equal and have shared responsibilities.

In the case of traditional marriages, both husbands and wives are comfortable with the idea that the husband is dominant. They have a set of expectations about how each partner should behave and they find their respective roles to be natural. However, sometimes they might have difficulty seeing their partner's side of issues. When conflicts arise, they are not well equipped to handle them because they see the world primarily from the perspective of their different gender roles.

Modern thinking couples can also have their difficulties. Women who expect equality and reject traditional gender roles won't sacrifice their personal happiness to save their marriage. When things are unfair and out of balance, they will react strongly. Moreover, because both partners believe **they** should have a say in all decisions, couples are forced to do more negotiating, and that increases the chances of fighting. A wife who thinks she's working harder than she should around the house and a husband who thinks his wife doesn't respect him, are more likely to result in arguments. This doesn't necessarily mean couples are less happy today, but anything that increases the chances of conflict puts a marriage at risk.
