It usually refers to the writer's experience

<b>INTRODUCTION</b>	<b>Who, when, where, what</b> My grandpa always tells me... Last summer I went to Thailand... I will never forget the moment when... Something really strange happened to me ....
<b>BEGINNING OF THE STORY</b>	<b>How it all started</b> "Stay in line" Mrs Martin said. The hotel was small but luxurious... The red carpet had a blood stain... <b>Chronological order of events</b> "Pepperoni pizza", I said politely. We went diving.... The black car was there again... I looked up and saw Naomi. She was laughing too. All those people were impressed... The police arrested the woman....

**Extra tips. To give it a tone:**

- (Un)fortunately,...

## WRITING A REVIEW

In a review you give your opinion of a book, concert, a place,... and say whether or not you recommend it. Although it is an opinion, try not to use an excess of personal information like: I went there with my family and friends to spend my holidays last year.

<b>Start with a general description.</b>	My favourite book is <i>The Neverending Story</i> , a fantasy and action book written by the German writer Michael Ende. It is definitely a must. <i>Marblava</i> is a new great hotel located right in the middle of a fantastic holiday resort: Platja d'Aro. <i>Massive Attack's</i> last week concert in Barcelona absolutely met my expectations.
<b>Description. Plot / Events</b>	<b>Use extreme adjectives and degree adverbs</b> <b>Adjectives:</b> Fascinating, huge, impressive, flawless, spotless, excellent, underrated, hilarious, endless,... <b>Adverbs:</b> Extremely, insanely, radically, too, completely, really, rather, fairly, quite, slightly
<b>Atmosphere and feelings.</b>	The story may seem a little confusing sometimes; however, just right before the end it all makes sense. There is a relaxing, silent, family atmosphere to it. Seeing such an enormous crowd sing along is an amazing show in itself.
<b>Give reasons for your opinion</b>	What I didn't love about it was... Although the final price might feel expensive, I assure you it is totally worth it. Despite the cost of the tickets and the queues one must stand to get to one of their concerts, they revealed themselves as an outstanding band one must totally follow.
<b>Sum up opinion. Clear recommendation</b>	In my opinion, it is a really well-written modern classic. Anyone who is a fan of small family-run hotels should spend some time there.

### Extra tips. Music events.

#### Useful phrases:

- The passion of the musicians heated up the audience
- At this point, the song was increasingly getting louder, and so was the audience.
- Impossible to hear the lead singer with all that noise around.

### Extra tips. Books or films:

- This well-written masterpiece is a must everyone should read.
- Although the end of the story may be a bit confusing, the evolution of the main character is outstanding.
- This film will have you on the edge of your seat until the very end.

### Extra tips. Final advice:

- I would recommend it to all nature lovers looking for peace and silence.
- I strongly recommend it to everyone.
- It was an enjoyable and stimulating experience
- Anyone being a fan of action films should watch it.
- You won't regret it.

<b>Useful phrases.</b>	You know? Guess what! It's been great! Wish you had been there! Thanks for everything!
<b>Conclusion</b>	That's all for now. I really need to head for my piano lesson. I must now go and do some work. Best of luck with your project! Write soon. Hope to hear from you soon.
<b>Ending</b>	Lots of love, Love, Best wishes, Be safe,
<b>Signature</b>	First name

#### Extra tips.

- Use (semi-) informal language (some exclamations, omission of the subject,...).
- Use contractions (can't, don't,...)
- Use phrasal verbs (look forward to, give up,...)
- Use short sentences.

#### Extra tips. Avoid:

- Slang or extreme informal language (ain't, sorta, wanna, gonna,...)
- Passive structures



WRITING A FORMAL E-MAIL	
Written to a professor, colleague, boss, etc. Must always be professional	
<b>SALUTATION</b>	Dear Professor Johnson, Dear Sir / Madam, Dear Mr. Bond, Dear Ms. Myers,
<b>INTRODUCTION</b> We will go straight to the point	I am sorry to tell you I am sick and will not be able to attend class. I am writing to complain about the article you published in your newspaper. I am writing to get more information about... I am writing concerning a problem that I had ... I am writing with reference to the above order, which I placed on your website on 2March.
<b>BODY.</b> <b>One or two paragraphs</b>	I am a graduate from Penn State University. The article in your newspaper mentioned... I purchased a watch which was not delivered until two weeks after it was ordered.
<b>LAST PARAGRAPH</b>	I would appreciate if you could send me further information. I would be grateful if you corrected your mistake publicly. I wondered if you could arrange a refund for my purchase. I would appreciate if the situation could be solved as soon as possible.
<b>CLOSING</b>	Thank you for your time. Looking forward to your answer. Best regards
<b>SIGNATURE</b>	Full name (Not your real name in exams).

### Extra tips.

- Use formal language. Contractions are unacceptable.
- Use connectors:  
Moreover,...  
Apart from the aforementioned,...  
Because of that,...  
As a result,...  
Unfortunately,...  
Nevertheless,...
- Use compound sentences.

### Extra tips.

Do not use personal references regarding feelings. Use impersonal structures or use more complex vocabulary.

#### Do not say:

I was annoyed

I was disappointed

I didn't like ...

#### Say:

It was annoying

It was disappointing

I was dissatisfied with...

Express out thoughts about a matter	
<b>INTRODUCTION</b> Introduce the topic and give your opinion, no details. We can also use questions.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• People often say that the teenage years are the best years of your life. However, I do not agree with the statement.</li> <li>• It is generally considered that dogs are the best pets. I absolutely agree with this.</li> <li>• It is worldwide known that big cities provide more services than small villages. However, is life better in bigger cities?</li> </ul>
Give a reason to support your opinion. Give examples.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Firstly</b>, most teenagers have little independence.</li> <li>• <b>In the first place</b>, dogs are loyal and affectionate.</li> <li>• <b>To begin with</b>, big cities provide a big quantity of services, and that is a great advantage you don't have in a rural area</li> </ul>
