Goal

Dancers tell stories by using different facial expressions. Instead of using words, dancers use their bodies, eye contact, and movement to express themselves just like in pantomime. Pantomime involves conveying a story with only bodily movements. The mime exaggerates movements and facial expressions. The goal is to portray personality characteristics and emotions to create believable scenarios. To collaborate with the music performance task, you will compose your own instrumental background music for your mime.

Students will:

- ✓ Choose a personality trait or activity with which you are comfortable and familiar.
- ✓ When you know exactly how something is done or a particular emotion feels, you can make your pantomime smooth and believable.
- ✓ Do different personality and character traits.
- ✓ Apply the elements of dance.
