1. (Executive/Judicial) branch of government is the state's court system.
2. (Legislative/Executive) branch of government makes the laws.
3. (Judicial/Executive) branch of government makes sure (executes) that state laws are carried out.
4. The (General Assembly/Supreme Court) is divided into two parts, the Senate and the House of Delegates.
5. Virginia (exports/imports) agricultural and manufactured products, including tobacco, poultry, coal and large ships.
6. Virginia's transportation system includes: highways, railroads, air transportation, and shipping, moves (finished/raw) materials to factories and finished products to markets.
7. (Fishing/Tourism) is a major part of Virginia's economy.
8. (Banking and lending/Chemical goods) are top products and services for Virginia.
9. Access to (deepwater ports/shallow ports) and proximity to the Chesapeake Bay and Atlantic Ocean makes shipbuilding, fishing, crabbing, and oyster harvesting possible.
10. Historically, the success of (Appalachian/Piedmont) coalfield was due to the expansion of railroads that transport coal to piers in Tidewater for shipment to both international and domestic markets.
