**Directions:** Now that you can identify the main parts of a computer, it's important to understand what each part does. Draw a line to match the computer part with the best description. Feel free to refer to the pictures in Activity #3 if you need help.

Computer Part	Description
1 Tower	<b>a</b> When given instructions to do so, this output device will place words and images on paper.
2 Mouse	<b>b</b> We can use this input device to type words, numbers, and symbols.
3 Keyboard	<b>c</b> We click the buttons on this input device to make choices and give the computer information. No wire is needed.
4 Touchpad	<b>d</b> This part is generally placed on the floor and contains smaller parts of a desktop computer.
5 Monitor	<b>e</b> This input device can be used to see and talk to family and friends around the world. It can also be used to make videos.
6 Printer	<b>f</b> We click the buttons on this input device to make choices and give the computer information.
7 Wireless Mouse	<b>g</b> This input device is generally used instead of a mouse when using a laptop and requires movements by one's fingers.
8 Webcam	<b>h</b> This output device presents information from the computer on the screen.
