Computer Part		Description	
1	Tower	a	When given instructions to do so, this output device will place words and images on paper.
2	Mouse	b	We can use this input device to type words, numbers, and symbols.
3	Keyboard	c	We click the buttons on this input device to make choices and give the computer information. No wire is needed.
4	Touchpad	d	This part is generally placed on the floor and contains smaller parts of a desktop computer.
5	Monitor	e	This input device can be used to see and talk to family and friends around the world. It can also be used to make videos.
6	Printer	f	We click the buttons on this input device to make choices and give the computer information.
7	Wireless Mouse	g	This input device is generally used instead of a mouse when using a laptop and requires movements by one's fingers.
8	Webcam	h	This output device presents information from the computer on the screen.
