Inuit - Artic Region

The Inuit people live in the far northern areas of Alaska, Canada, Siberia, and Greenland. Temperature in these Arctic areas are below freezing much of the year. The Inuit used natural resources from this frozen environment to live.

Their lives depended on the animals that lived in this region. They followed the roaming herds of caribou, seal, fish, walrus and migrating birds such as ducks and geese. These animals were their main source of food and were also used for shelter and clothing. They made shirts, pants, boots, hats, and big jackets called anoraks from caribou and seal skin.

During the summer they lived in tents made out of animal skin and plant materials. They would also make igloo structure made out of ice and snow in winter.
