## NEGATIVE

## INTERROGATIVE

- Am I going to play tennis?
- Are we/you/they going to play tennis?
- Is he/she/ it going to play tennis?

## SHORT ANSWERS

- Yes, I am. / No, I'm not.
- Yes, we/you/they are. / No, we/you/they aren't
- Yes, he/she/it is. / No, he/ she/ it isn't.

## USE:

1- Talk about plans and intentions.

We are going to travel to Rome next summer.

2- When there's evidence that something is going to happen in the future.

Look at the grey clouds. It's going to rain soon.
