3. Realiza las siguientes divisiones.

A subtraction problem is shown using a place value chart. The numbers are 896 and 8. The chart has columns for hundreds, tens, and ones. The number 896 is represented by 8 hundreds blocks, 9 tens blocks, and 6 ones blocks. The number 8 is represented by 8 ones blocks. The subtraction is set up as follows:

The subtraction is performed from right to left. In the ones column, 6 minus 8 is not possible, so one ten block is traded for ten ones blocks. This leaves 9 tens blocks and 16 ones blocks. Then, 16 minus 8 equals 8. In the tens column, 9 minus 0 equals 9. In the hundreds column, 8 minus 0 equals 8. The final result is 898.
