Bonelli Eagle is an endangered species. This is why GREFA, a **rescue organization**, and the **Forest rangers** are developing a project called **Aquila-a-LIFE** to take care of these birds.

An important thing they do is patrol the eagles' **nests**. When they observe a nest and identify **sick chicks** they take them to their hospital so they can save them.

Bonelli Eagles are given a *GPS* device by these group of rescuers to know where they are, how they are and also to learn more about this species.

Also, **GREFA** checks **electricity posts** and makes sure they are safe. They have volunteers who locate the most dangerous **power lines** and try to change them.

With those eagles that are taken into the hospital and which cannot be **let back into the wild**, GREFA breeds new baby chicks in **captivity** which will be later set free. On the first days when they are free it is very important that **GREFA feed** them and check how they develop.
