Subject pronouns replace the subject of the sentence.

Subject Pronouns are: **I, you, he, she, it, we, they**

1. **Kate and her family** went to the river.
2. **My dogs and I** go for a walk every morning.
3. Can wash the dishes?
4. **James** helps his grandfather on the weekends.
5. **An owl** is flapping its wings on the tree branch.
6. **Aly** has two cats called Midnight and Snickers.

The object of the sentence is who or what **receives** the action.

Object pronouns replace the object of the sentence.

Object Pronouns are: **me, you, him, her, it, us, them**

1. The cellphone is charging on **the table**.
2. Yohan and Soso are going to visit **Triston**.
3. Miss Lennon and her students are going to visit **the other students**.
4. Can you go to the movies with ?
5. The fish jumped into the boat with my **family and me**?
6. I am going to my grandmother's house to help clean.
