

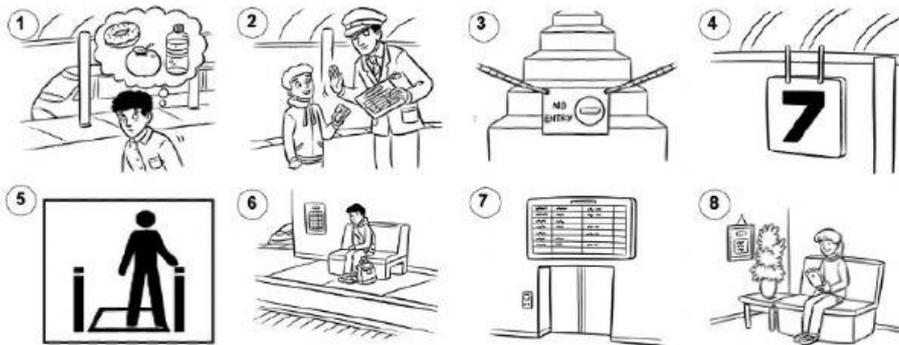
# UNIT 3
