

Verbs – Regular Past Tense

The past tense is used to express an action which has happened in the past.

Some past tense of verbs can be formed by adding 'ed'.

E.g wash-washed, rush-rushed

Some past tense of verbs can be formed by adding 'd' when the verb ends with 'e'.

E.g dance-danced, share-shared

Form the past tense of the following verbs.

- 10) Warn-

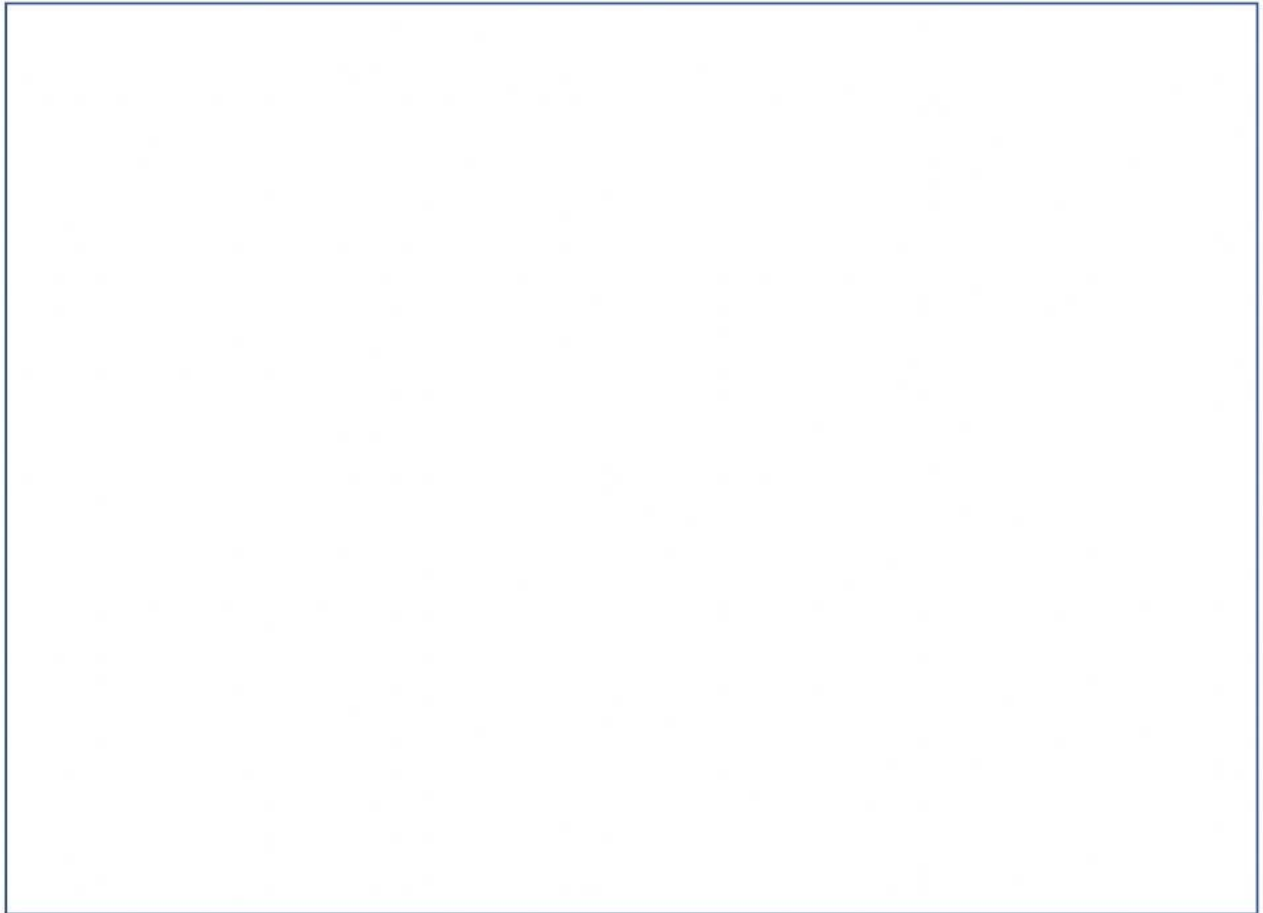
Some past tense of verbs can be formed by doubling the last letter of a verb, and adding 'ed' when a single vowel precedes the last letter of the word.

E.g. drop-dropped, travel-travelled

If the last letter of the verb is preceded by a double vowel, the last letter is not doubled before adding 'ed'.

E.g. float-floated, cheat-cheated
