

QUESTIONS IN THE PRESENT CONTINUOUS



Yes-No Questions:

People answer yes-no questions by saying **YES** or **NO**.

Example:

A: Are you watching TV now?

B: **Yes**, I am.

(or) **No**, I'm not.

Remember the structures:

Am

Is

Are

+

Person

+ verb **-ing**?

**Present continuous:
Yes-No questions**

Am I working?

Are you working?

Is he working?

Is she working?

Is it working?

Are we working?

Are you working?

Are they working?

Look at the pictures and read the examples:



A: **Are** they working right now?

B: **Yes**, they **are**.



A: **Are** they working right now?

B: **No**, they **aren't**.

(They are riding a roller coaster).

<p>Is she sleeping?</p> <p>Yes, she is. No, she isn't.</p>		
<p>Is it working?</p> <p>Yes, it is. No, it isn't.</p> <p>(it = the computer)</p>	 <p>Is it working now?</p> <p>No, it isn't.</p>	
<p>Are you having fun?</p> <p>Yes, we are. No, we aren't.</p>	 <p>Are you having fun?</p> <p>Yes, we are.</p> <p>Yes, we are.</p>	
<p>Are they flying?</p> <p>Yes, they are. No, they aren't.</p> <p>(they = the child and the woman in the plane)</p>	 <p>Are they flying now?</p> <p>Yes, they are.</p>
