

Multiplication - Worded Problems

Example:

Mary had 4 piles with 3 oranges in each pile. How many oranges did she have altogether?  $4 \times 3 = 12$ oranges

1. Aleem had 5 sets of three Lego blocks in his bag.
How many blocks did he have altogether?



$$\underline{\quad} \times \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad} \text{ blocks}$$

2. Beena used 4 sets of 2 eggs to make a cake.
How many eggs did she use?



$$\underline{\quad} \times \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad} \text{ eggs}$$

3. There were 6 sets of 3 birds sitting on a wire.
How many birds were on the wire?



$$\underline{\quad} \times \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad} \text{ birds}$$

4. Mr. Ali bought 6 bunches of 5 flowers.



How many flowers did he buy altogether?

$$\underline{\quad} \times \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad} \text{ flowers}$$

5. Candace had 4 marbles in each of 3 tins.



How many marbles did she have altogether?

$$\underline{\quad} \times \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad} \text{ marbles}$$
