The Emperor decided that empire was too big to rule properly.

The empire was running out of money. Emperors wasted money on expensive parties and building projects. Roman leaders raised taxes, so people rebelled.

Many tribes attacked the Roman empire. Roman called these people BARBARIANS. There were so many attacks that the army could not defend all the towns.

Emperors were not chosen because of their abilities. Some times they bribed people to get the job. There were many arguments between important Romans. Many emperors were assassinated.

Emperor Diocletian divided the empire into Eastern Roman Empire and Western Roman Empire. The Western had its capital in Rome, while the Eastern had its capital in Byzantium. There many wars and disagreements because of this split

The empire grew and there were nt enough soldiers to defend it. Many non-Roman soldiers were recruited, but they were not committed to the Empire, so the Army became weaker. They did not always follow instructions in battle.
